

PCATDES Will Hold an International Workshop at Hanoi, Vietnam on 13 January 2017

PCATDES is an ambitious collaborative project between the European Union of South East Asian Nations (ASEAN), financially supported by the European Commission under its Seventh Framework Programme, grant number 309846.

The European Commission Funded, FP7 PCATDES Project will hold an International Workshop at The Melia Hotel, Hanoi, Vietnam on 13 January 2017.

This EU/ASEAN Collaboration has researched and investigated new approaches for developing Photocatalytic Materials for the Destruction of Recalcitrant Organic Industrial Waste. 11 Partners from 7 Countries and 2 Continents have worked harmoniously together to develop scaled up, photocatalytic reactors which will be field tested in Malaysia; Thailand and Vietnam until the Project End, on 31 January 2017.

The International Workshop, on Friday 13 January 2017, will feature, in particular, many of the young Researchers who have made significant contributions to the PCATDES Project. These young researchers have benefited from working with and being mentored by experienced, specialist, highly regarded scientists involved with the PCATDES Project. PCATDES will leave a body of research to be exploited by other academics; institutions and industry.
